The Chairman and the CEO of UGF, Stefanini and Salvatori, received at the Quirinale this morning by President Napolitano

The Chairman and the Chief Executive Officer of Unipol Gruppo Finanziario, Pierluigi Stefanini and Carlo Salvatori, were received this morning at the Quirinale by the President of the Republic, Giorgio Napolitano.

The Group is celebrating its forty-fifth anniversary this year and Stefanini and Salvatori told the Head of State of the recent changes in its corporate structure, its new system of governance and its strategies for integrating and expanding its insurance, banking and financial activities.
