The meeting will be opened by the Chairman of Unipol's Regional Board in Piedmont Michele Sabatino and closed by Unipol Gruppo Finanziario's Human Resources and Organisation Director Giuseppe Santella.

This event will provide UGF with the opportunity to give its partners and the entire community an account of its strategies, its objectives and the initiatives it has undertaken, as part of its corporate responsibility, contained in its 2010-2012 Sustainability Plan, which will be presented along with its 2009 Sustainability Report in order to provide a complete picture of the financial, social and environmental decisions made by the Group and at the same time to provide it with an opportunity to invite discussion and suggestions for improvement.

This will be followed by the handing over of the Unipolis Foundation 'Keys to Smiles' grant. The project selected for the region of Piedmont is 'Radio Jam', put forward by the social cooperative **Atypica**. The main aim of the project is to get children who attend the youth centres and the music rehearsal room in Rivalta di Torino to set up an Internet radio station and to link it up with other Piedmont Internet radio stations.
