**THE UNIPOL GROUP EXTENDS ITS HEALTHCARE POLICY COVER AT NO**  
**EXTRA CHARGE AND MAKES THE UNISALUTE MEDICAL CENTRE AVAILABLE**  
**24/7**

The Unipol Group is protecting its customers with insurance solutions and 24/7 assistance to deal with the healthcare situation in our country due to the spread of the Covid-19 virus (Coronavirus).

The healthcare policies that the Unipol Group offers its customers can include different types of cover that also apply in the event of infection by Coronavirus: expenses incurred for specialist visits or diagnostic tests, daily allowance for hospital admissions, daily allowance for convalescence, home hospitalisation expenses after hospitalisation and useful telephone assistance services available 24/7 including immediate medical opinions.

In addition to the insurance cover already included, as an extraordinary measure due to the current situation, the Group has also decided to extend the award of a daily allowance, at no extra charge, to any insured parties who are put into quarantine at home after testing positive for Covid-19.

This measure applies to all people insured with UnipolSai, UniSalute or Arca who are already covered for hospitalisation allowances, at no additional cost.

Insured parties who have health insurance with any of the Group companies can also contact the Coronavirus medical consultation service at no extra charge, 24/7, through the UniSalute Medical Centre, the Group company devoted to prevention and the protection of health. Customers can use the toll-free number on their insurance policies relating to their healthcare plans to access the service.

UniSalute has also introduced an information campaign through its corporate channels (including the "InSalute" blog) to spread awareness of the best strategies to adopt to prevent the Coronavirus in

order to make the public more aware of this issue of international significance. The articles are drafted in association with the virologists on its Scientific Committee.
